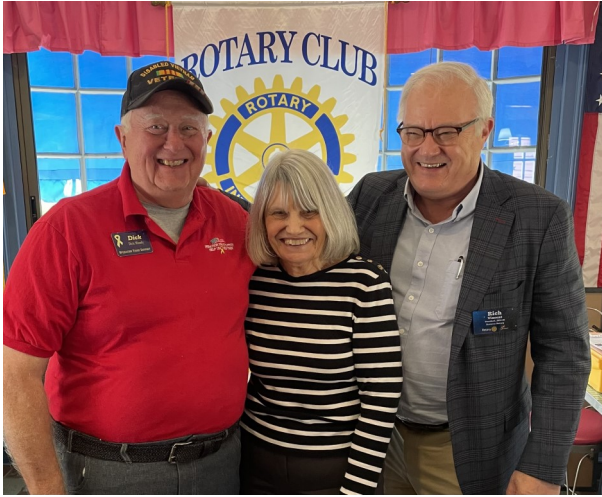

Dick Moody—Operation Troop Support



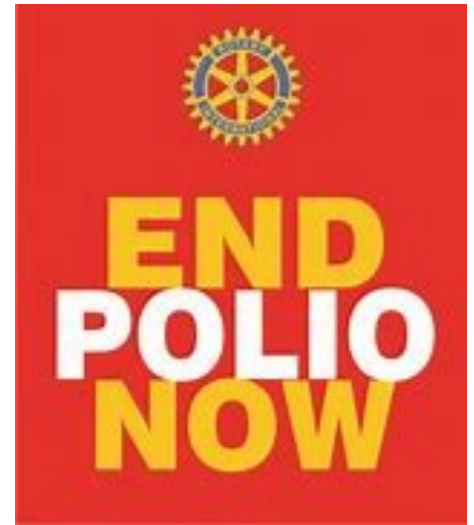

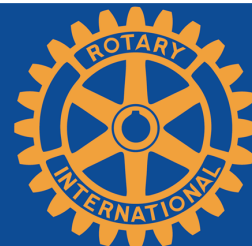
Save the Date: RYLA 2025
