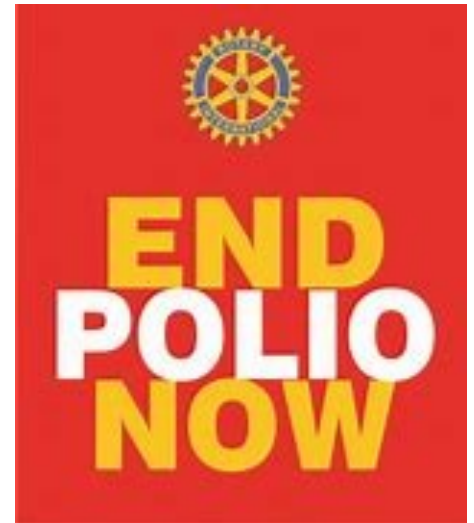

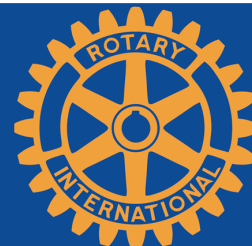
AUTUMN TURKEY WRAP
